

- 1) Dementia - increase Diagnosis Rates to 60% and improve access to treatment. Ensuring there is sufficient capacity for step down and on-going management.** NHS England has set the first ever national ambition to improve dementia diagnosis rates. The plans aim to see two-thirds of people with dementia identified and given appropriate support by 2015, an increase from 39% in 2010 and the current average of about 45% (CCG is currently at 47.5%). The estimated number of dementia cases is calculated using the National Dementia Prevalence Rates (NDPR). The NDPR are taken from the Alzheimer's Society's report Dementia UK (2007) and are held to be the best UK rates available based on age and gender. Challenge for practices in identifying patients.
  
- 2) Improved Access to Psychological Services (IAPS) - 13% of people to receive psychological services. (15% by April 2015)**  
The primary purpose of this indicator is to measure improved access to psychological services for people with depression and/or anxiety disorders, in order to address the enduring unmet need. The estimated number of people is based on the national Psychiatric Morbidity Survey then extrapolated for each CCG and practice based on total list size.
  
- 3) Health Checks - Increase number of patients receiving health checks to 10% of eligible population (National recommendation)** Aim is to promote health and wellbeing, self-management and early diagnosis leading to improved outcomes.
  
- 4) Stop Smoking Services - increase number accessing service to 8.5%.** Aim is to increase life expectancy by increasing the number of patients accessing stop smoking services and subsequent number of quitters.
  
- 5) Hypertension - Increase prevalence rate to 16%** Increase number of patients on GP practice QOF register diagnosed with hypertension (closer towards modelled estimates) thereby improving health and wellbeing and reducing health related comorbidities. Challenge for practices in identifying patients.
