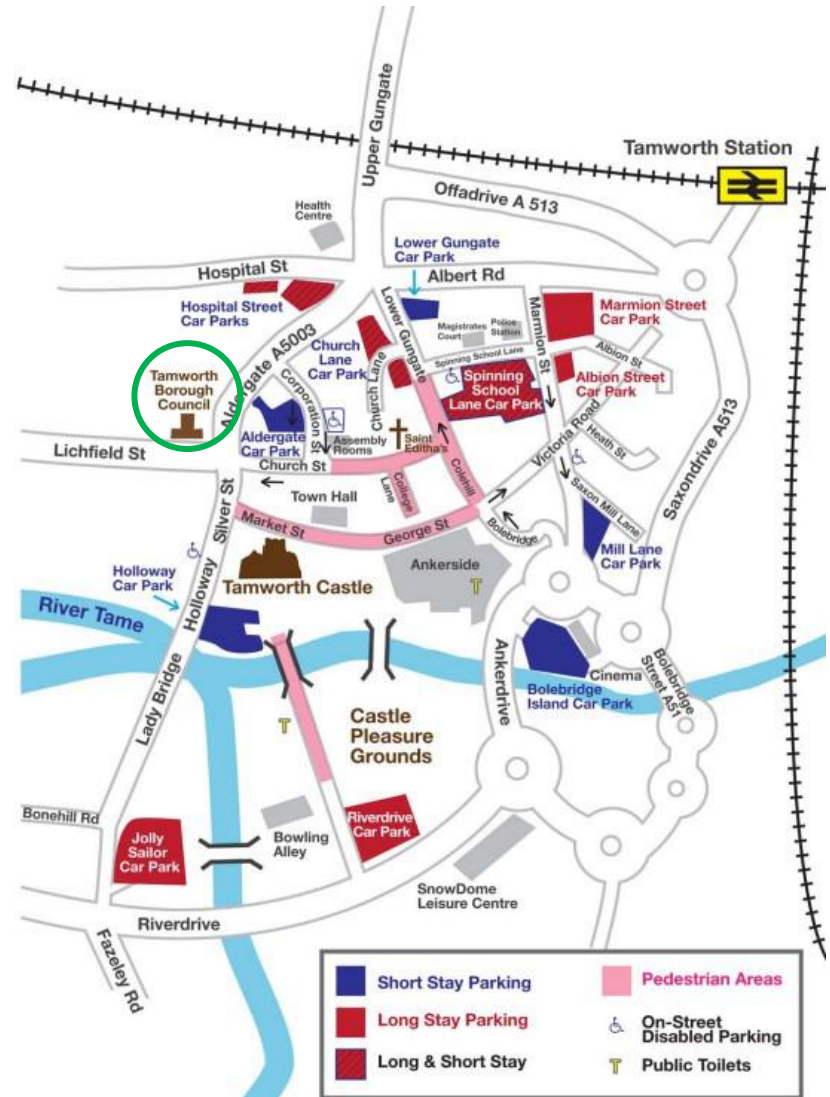

All car parks operate 24 hours a day. The chargeable period is between 8am and 6pm, Monday to Saturday. For blue badge holders, parking is free of charge on Tamworth Borough Council run car parks.

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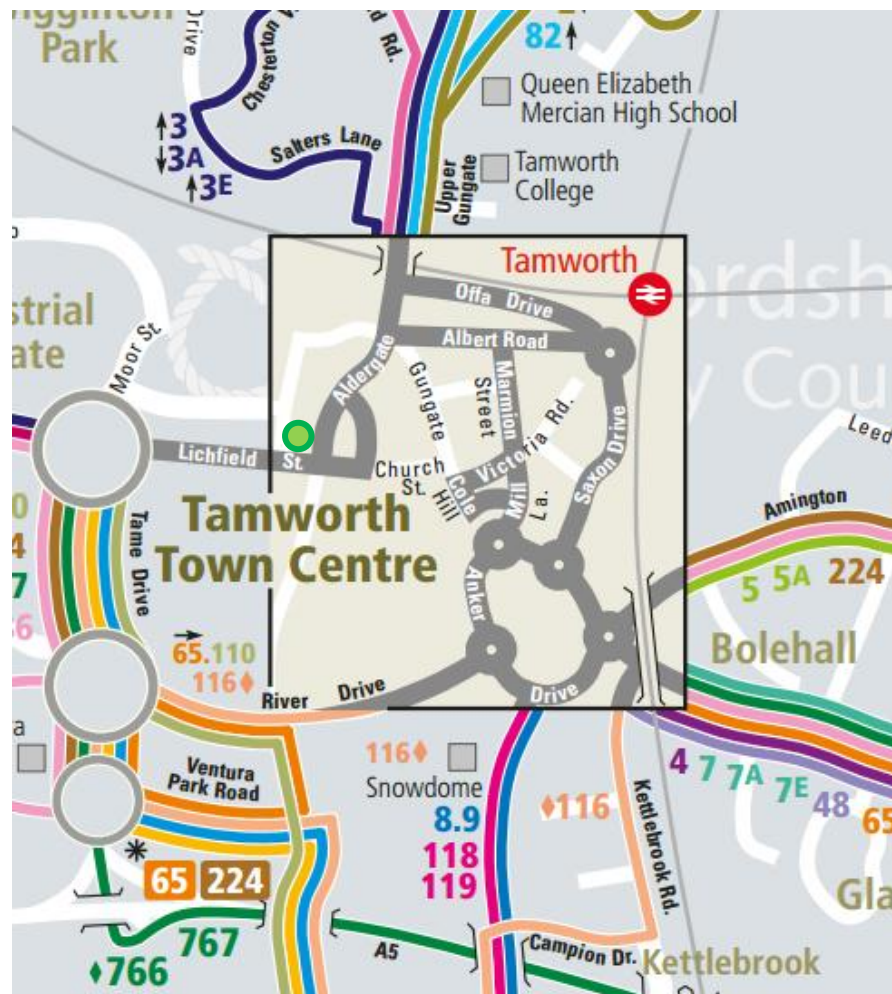

How to find Staffordshire Place 2, Stafford

Note the building is opposite Staffordshire Place 1, which houses the library.



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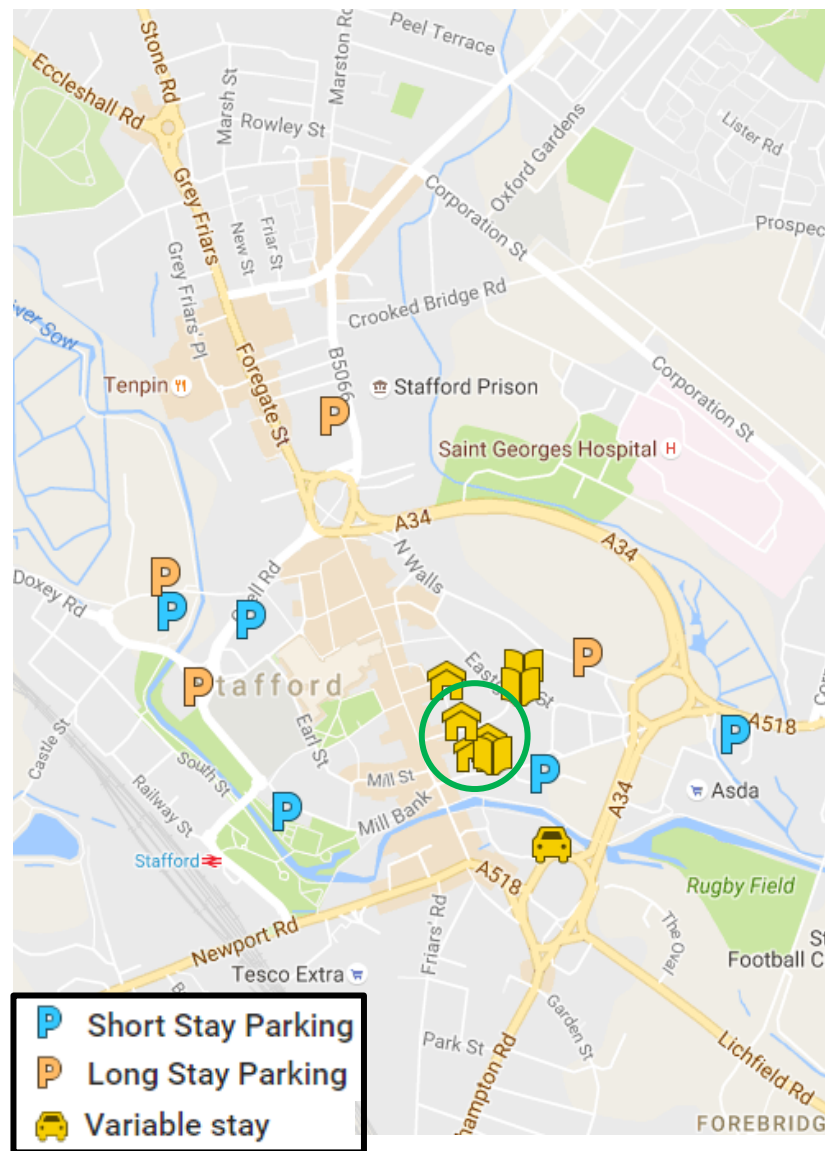

Parking for Staffordshire Place 2, Stafford

Staff and visitors need to park on the various car parks in the town.

Waterfront multi-storey and Riverside short stay car parks are operated by chip coin pay on foot technology meaning you only pay for the time you have been parked. Charges apply at all times and to all vehicles including blue badge holders. Surface car parks are all pay and display with the option of cashless pay by phone parking. They are open all hours and charges apply between 8am and 6pm, Mon to Sat.

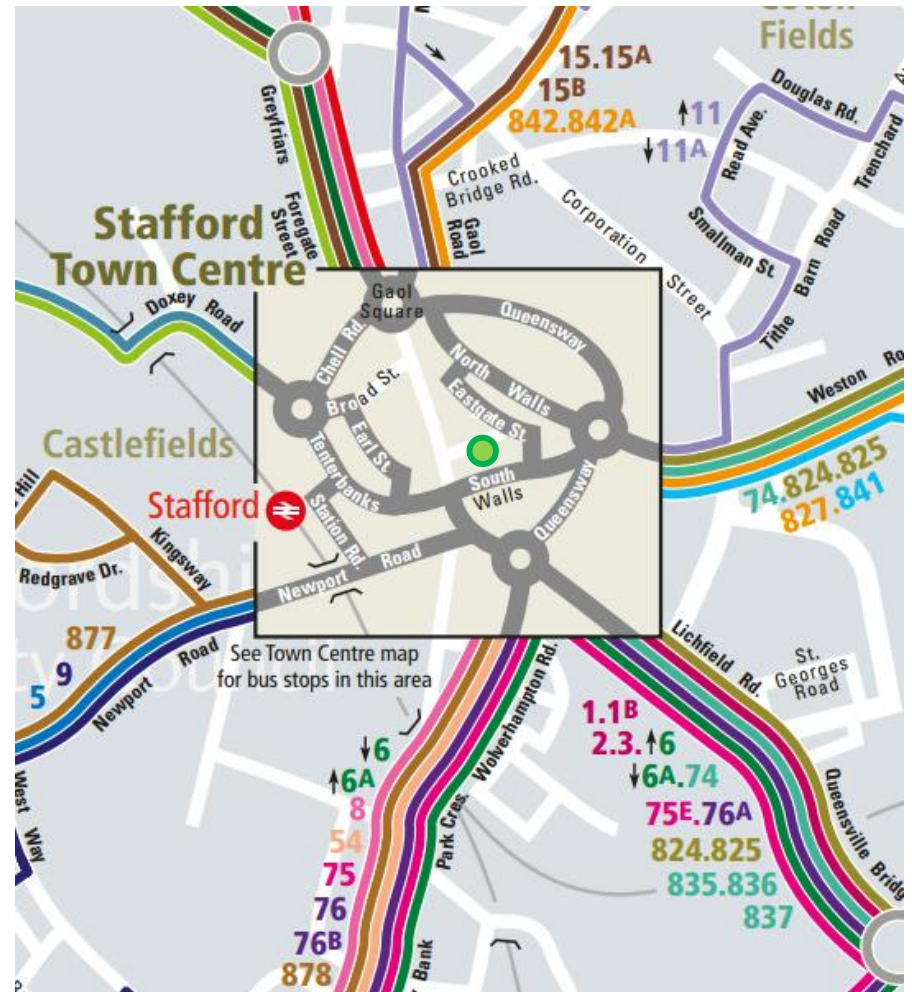


Public transport to Staffordshire Place 2, Stafford

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Comfort and safety (both Tamworth and Stafford)

Toilets

- Toilets can be found next to the lifts in both buildings. At Marmion House the disabled toilets are on the ground floor only.

Meeting rooms

- Staff and visitors are requested to leave meeting rooms clear for the next meeting and with equipment and lights turned off where practical.

Access requirements

- Where possible, please advise of any fair access needs in advance of your visit.



Fire alarms

- In the case of an audible fire alarm, staff will lead you to a designated safe exit. Fire exit routes and stairs are clearly signposted overhead.
- In the case of a fire, lifts are not to be used. Evacuation chairs should be available and several staff members are trained to operate this equipment.
- There is a designated external assembly point in case of a fire. Fire Wardens (dressed in high-visibility jackets) will make sure that all staff and visitors are safely escorted from the building.

Fair access to information

We want to make sure that information is accessible to everyone. Patients, the public and staff can request reasonable adjustments such as information in other formats.

To request information in an alternative format such as braille, larger print, audio or other format or you may require additional support e.g. a British Sign Language (BSL) interpreter to support you or you may need language support where your first spoken language is not English.
